ENGLISH 095 - BASIC WRITING

This developmental course is a review of English grammar, mechanics, terminology, and rules as they apply to writing and revising at the sentence and paragraph levels. It includes techniques for creating introductions, topic sentences, transitional sentences, and conclusions. It also emphasizes vocabulary development.

ENGLISH 096 - INTERMEDIATE WRITING

This developmental course is a study of intermediate writing skills, with emphasis on unity, support, and coherence of ideas. It includes a general review of vocabulary, homophones, grammar, punctuation, usage, and paragraph and essay writing skills. It also covers college-level research skills and analysis of short fiction.
