Contract for Honors Credit

- Enrollment in an approved general education (GENED) course for Honors credit requires successful completion of at least 12 GENED credits and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- •This contract must be submitted to the Honors Program Chair and formally approved by the Chair, the Honors Advisory Board and the Instructor's Dean.
- The specifics of this contract are a collaborative enterprise of the faculty mentor and the student. The proposed project should demonstrate academic rigor and anticipated student time commitment that goes above and beyond the regular learning objectives for the course.
- •Once approved, the faculty mentor, student and Honors Program Chair will each retain a copy of the final contract.
- Faculty mentors are compensated up to a maximum of three Honors students per semester. Additional uncompensated units are allowed.
